

Questions 1 – 2: Pramod, Quin, Richa, Stanley and Triveni are sitting in a row watching a Bond movie. Pramod is sitting adjacent to Quin, Richa is sitting adjacent to Stanley, who is not sitting with Triveni, who is on the left end of the row. Pramod is to the right of Quin and Triveni. Richa is on the second position from the right end. Pramod and Richa are sitting together.

- 1) In which position Pramod is sitting?

Questions 15 – 19:

 - Figo, which is third to the left of Alto, is at one end.

Basic Assumptions and Answer Key:

- a) The person who solve linear (row wise) seating arrangement questions is supposed to face the direction of people (or objects) in the arrangement face. (Eg: If the people in an arrangement face sunrise then the person solving that arrangement should assume s/he faces sunrise (east)).
- b) Your left is the left of the linear arrangement and your right is the right of the arrangement.
- c) In circular arrangement questions, if the direction of the people is not specifically given, then we have to assume everyone is facing the center.

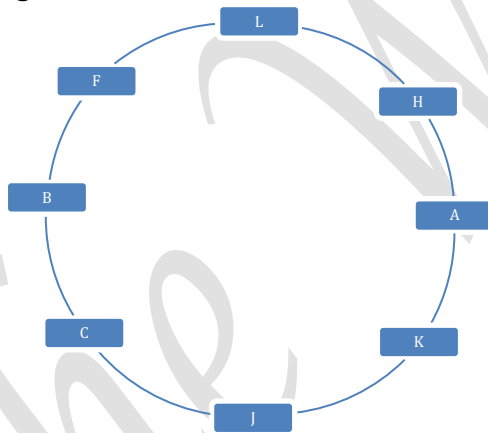

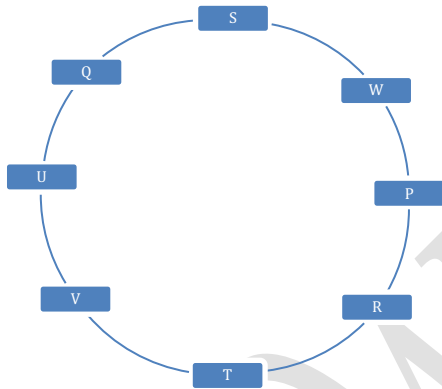
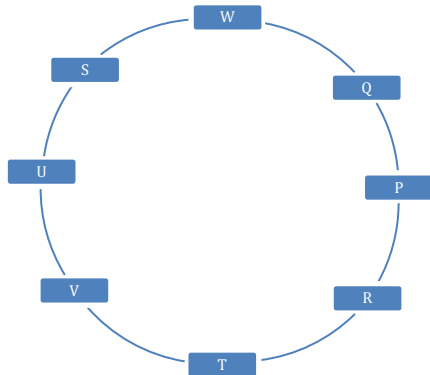
