Questions 1 – 4:

Six stage performers C, F, G, H, J and K perform stage shows on different days from Monday to Saturday, not necessarily in the same order. Each one performs a different item, viz. Dance, Mimicry, Play, Drama, Music and Monologue, not necessarily in the same order. K performs 'Mimicry' but not on Tuesday or Saturday. G's performance is on the next day of K's performance. F performs 'Play' on Thursday. H performs on Monday but not 'Dance' or 'Drama'. C performs 'Monologue' which is on the next day of 'Music'. 'Dance' is not performed on Saturday.

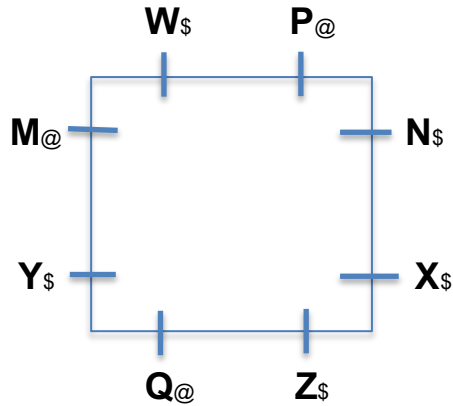
